- Our 1st Annual Post-Holiday Yearly Kickoff Party (we've got to come up with a better name for this) is scheduled for 4:00PM, Saturday, February 6th, in the banquet room at Marie Callender's, 2149 E. Convention Way, Ontario. Club members decided at the January club meeting that all members will pay for their own dinner approximately \$20 per person. Dinner will include salad, cornbread, choice from 3 different entrees, tea, coffee or soft drinks, and choice from 3 different pies. We will also have a gift exchange like we have done before at our Christmas parties. Men will bring a man's gift to exchange, women will bring a woman's gift to exchange. Suggested value is \$20 minimum.
- Muscle Cars At The Strip, March 18-20 at Las Vegas Motor Speedway in Las Vegas 2016 looks to be the biggest event ever now that the event has been opened up to also include Ford and General Motors muscle cars. I know most prefer the original all-Mopar format of years past, but I realize the economic realities and benefits of opening the event to the "SOBs" (some other brands) in order to both grow and help ensure the continuing success of this annual event. Parking for the "other guys" should be separated from our beloved Mopars and both the show car judging and drag racing will also separate the makes. Almost all of the drag racing classes will be divided into "Mopar vs. The World" formats. If you want to run only against other Mopars, then you better enter either the Slant Six class or the Arrington New Hemi/Modern Muscle Challenge class.

Personally, I'm looking forward to seeing the historic "SOBs" in the Stock/Super Stock/NSS class and also in the Nostalgia Super Stock/AFX class.

The event information flyer shows car show and racing pre-registration closes on March 5^{th} . Also, the Fun Field portion of the car show is only available by pre-registration. Fun Field parking will not be available for purchase at the event.

We will have more event schedule information in the February newsletter so be on the lookout for it.

So, what's the opinion? Simply this: while most club members build classic Mopar restorations or restomods, you really have to admire what "modern muscle" has to offer. Back in the golden musclecar years of the late 60s and early 70s, who would have ever thought we would see the Big Three manufacturers cranking out cars with the performance and reliability available today?

The Hellcat Challengers and Chargers are amazing road cars capable of outstanding performance with their 707-horsepower Hemi powerplants. And if that isn't enough for you then take a look at the new March 2016 issue of *Hot Rod Magazine* where High Horse Performance in Smyrna, Delaware pushes a Hellcat Challenger into the 9-second bracket with nothing more than a few bolt-ons! They baselined the 'Cat at 634 horsepower and 617 lb-ft *at the rear wheels*, then added aftermarket long-tube headers and full exhaust system, a larger crank pulley to increase the boost from the stock blower, new airbox,

cooler thermostat and a custom tuning package to get 733 horsepower and 677 lb-ft at the wheels. Changed the tune to allow running Q16 race gas for another 45 HP and 37 lb-ft. Finally, they added a 150-shot of nitrous and ended up with 908 horsepower and 930 lb-ft of torque at the tires! And without ever opening up the factory-built engine. Not only will that get you back from the store before the ice cream melts, that will get you home from the fast food burger joint before the fries even begin to cool!

The next club meeting is at Carrow's restaurant in Rancho Cucamonga on Sunday, February 7^{th} . I'll see you all at the usual time: 9:00AM for breakfast with our meeting starting as close to 10:00AM as possible. I know, I know. That's Super Bowl Sunday. We'll have you on your way home well in time for the game. Kickoff isn't until 3:30PM PDT, and do you really need to watch eight hours of pre-game?

Speaking of the Super bowl...did you notice the change in the game logo? Since "SUPER BOWL L" would have looked like a typographical error, game organizers replaced the "L" with "50" - but don't worry Roman numeral fans. The tradition continues with Super Bowl LI next year in Houston.
