A couple of the wives asked Ken Hamer for the recipe of the meat marinade used on the beef and chicken kabobs we had at the club picnic. The ladies asked, so guys share this with your better half!

Here it is:

- * 2-2/3 cups olive oil
- * 2-2/3 cups soy sauce
- * 1-1/2 cups red wine vinegar
- * 2 cups honey
- * 16 cloves garlic (minced) - or bottled minced garlic equivalent
- * 1-1/2 tsp. ground ginger
