So Dodge starts up the factory horsepower wars a couple of years ago with the introduction of the 707-horsepower Hellcat Challenger. Then they bring out the Hellcat Charger, which is now a 204-MPH four-door sedan to carry the family home from the grocery store before the ice cream melts. Then they announce they are going to bring out a Hellcat-engined Jeep Grand Cherokee - for some high-speed rock crawling?

Then what happens? Both GM and Ford up the ante by announcing a 650-horsepower ZL1 Camaro and a 526-horsepower Shelby GT350R Mustang respectively. Ford even announces a 626-horsepower V6 as the power plant for their new 2017 Ford GT!

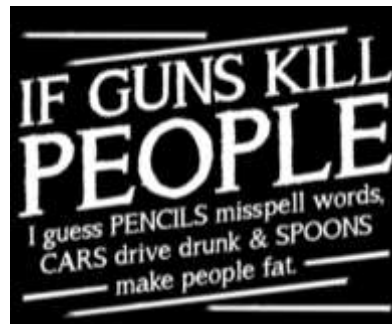
