2 Samuel 1:25

In the Arlington National Cemetery, at least 5,000 people gathered at the grave site of over 20,000 Union and Confederate soldiers. They respectfully decorated each grave. Later the day was changed and called Memorial Day. It became a day to honor all of our men and women who died in war

Memorial Day became an official holiday in 1971. It was traditionally observed on May 30, but now it is on the last Monday in May making the observance a three-day weekend. 
