



SEMA Stolen Car Report



STOLEN: ProCharger's 2018 Challenger SEMA Booth Vehicle

On this Halloween evening, we are reporting on a "nightmare with a happy ending." According to ProCharger, the 2018 Dodge Challenger SRT built by Quintin Brothers Auto and Performance, which had just arrived in Las Vegas, NV to be in ProCharger's SEMA display, was stolen. The 700+ horsepower supercharged, wide-body Challenger went on a 12-hour joy ride with four police cars in hot pursuit. Ten more cars joined the pursuit until the suspect crashed the Challenger into a police car, ending the chase.

Damage to the car is extensive, but thankfully no one was injured. In a bizarre tale that ended much like the Challenger chase scene in *Vanishing Point*, the exterior was destroyed, the stereo was stolen and a baby seat was added to the back seat. In the hours that followed the initial news, an outpouring of good will came from social media – offering to replace the car for the booth. But the Quintin Brothers and ProCharger, and even the Las Vegas Police Department, agreed the cars deserved to be in the booth. You can expect to see the Challenger in ProCharger's booth next week, untouched as it left the crime scene. Stay tuned to Street Muscle's Facebook page for photos of the car from the 2019 SEMA Show.




