- 1981 NASCAR #22 Buick Regal
- 1937 Ford XL-1 (Experimental Lincoln #1) Coupe a race car that for close to 15 years during the 50s and 60s was the terror of many east coast NASCAR Modified racers
- 1973 NASCAR #96 Mercury Montego

#### ...and for Mopar:

- 1964 NASCAR #777 Plymouth Belvedere once competed in by Marty Robbins that was rescued from the "rustworms" and completely restored
- 1964 Plymouth Belvedere "For Ply" A 200 mph street car sitting on a NASCAR chassis that once competed in the Daytona 500 and powered by a 358ci Dodge R5-P7 engine
- 1969 NASCAR #42 Dodge Daytona originally built by James Hylton and purchased by Bobby Allison

- 6. Do not lay rubber while traveling in a funeral procession.


