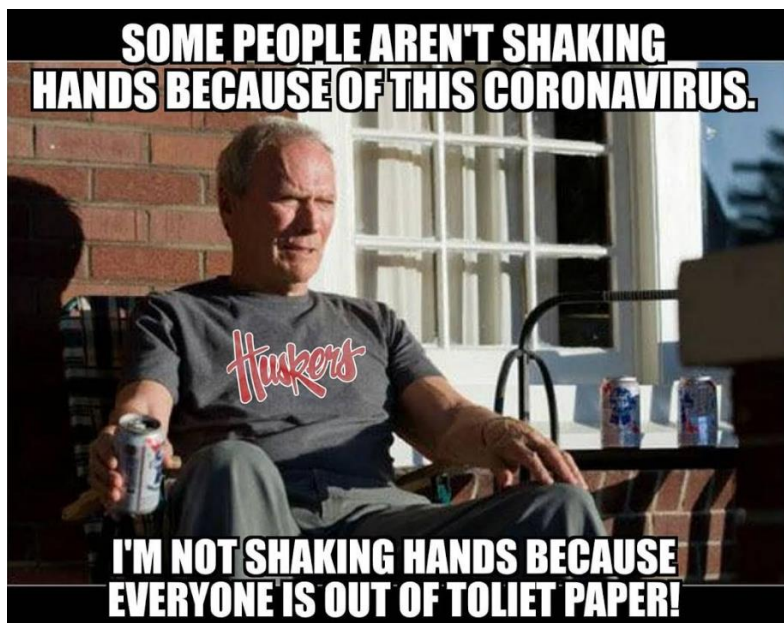

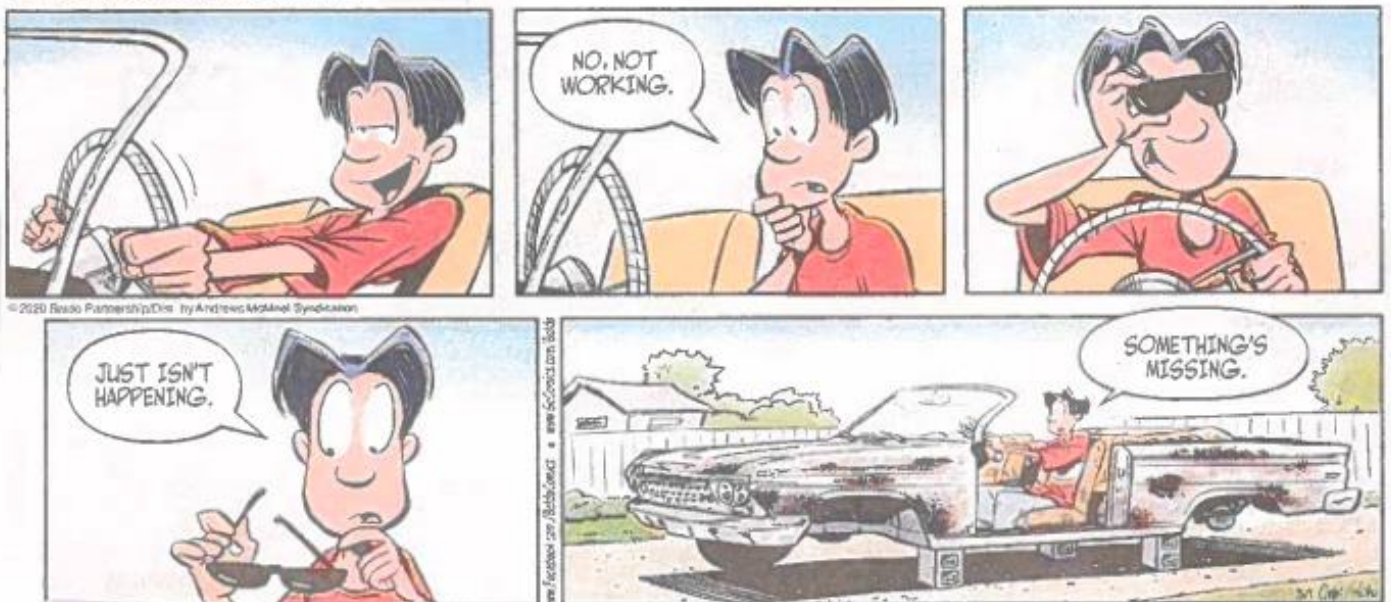
There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 11:15 AM.

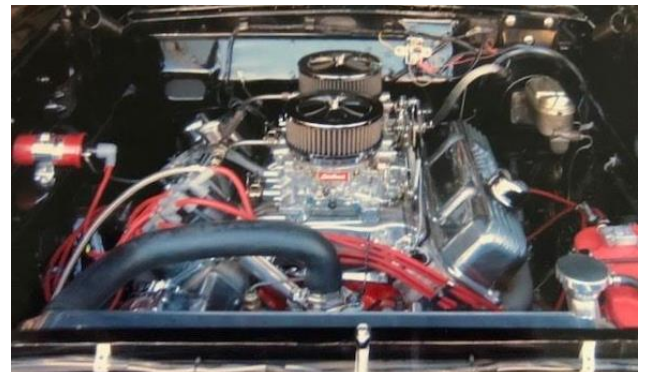
